EXPLANATORY NOTES ON THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1	<p>Adoption of the Provisional Agenda The Committee will be invited to adopt the Provisional Agenda as its Agenda for the Session.</p>
Item 2	<p>Matters referred to the Committee by the Codex Alimentarius Commission and Codex committees Matters of interest/referred to the Committee arising from the Codex Alimentarius Commission and other relevant Codex committees are presented for information and/or consideration by the Committee.</p>
Items 3, 4, 5a, 5b	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Proposed draft Codex Standard for Grated Desiccated Coconut (revision of CODEX STAN 177-1991, for reference on sampling see CX/MAS 1-1987) - Proposed draft Codex Standard for Table Olives (revision of CODEX STAN 66-1981) - Proposed draft Codex Standard for Canned Mushrooms (revision of CODEX STAN 55-1981) - Proposed draft Codex Standard for Canned Bamboo Shoots (revision of CODEX STAN 241-2003) <p>Particular attention should be paid to those provisions that need further discussion as identified in the working documents in order to facilitate their consideration by the Committee. Consideration of the above items will also take into account the recommendations arising from the physical meetings of the working groups that will take place prior to the Plenary.</p>
Item 6	<p>Proposed draft Sampling Plans including Metrological Provisions for Controlling Minimum Drained Weight of Canned Fruits and Vegetables in Packing Media Particular attention should be paid to the issue concerning whether the requirements for lot acceptance for minimum drained weight currently applying to Codex standards for canned fruits and vegetables in packing media are enough for the purposes of ensuring fair trade practices (sampling plan with an AQL = 6.5) or should be revised in terms of the provisions contained in the proposed sampling plan (sampling plan with an AQL = 2.5). Consideration of this item will also take into account the recommendations arising from the physical meeting of the working group that will take place prior to the Plenary.</p>
Item 7	<p>Food Additive Provisions for Processed Fruits and Vegetables: <i>Additional provisions for inclusion in selected adopted standards Standards for Pickled Fruits and Vegetables</i> (CODEX STAN 260-2007), <i>Processed Tomato Concentrates</i> (CODEX STAN 57-1981), <i>Preserved Tomatoes</i> (CODEX STAN 57-1981) and <i>Certain Canned Citrus Fruits</i> (CODEX STAN 254-2007) Additional food additive provisions for these standards are appended to the report of the last session of the Committee for comments on the technological justification for their use and associated proposed levels, and further consideration at its next session. The remaining additive provisions, including proposals for new additions for possible insertion in the aforesaid Standards, are for consideration by the Committee.</p>
Item 8a	<p>Consideration of revision of Codex standards for quick frozen fruits and vegetables and remaining canned fruits and vegetables The Committee agreed to consider all the remaining standards for canned fruits and vegetables and those for quick frozen fruits and vegetables in order to determine whether they are still relevant and necessary and if so, whether they need to be revised totally, partially or at all, and to examine the feasibility to group them into more horizontal standards similar to the approach taken with other general standards developed by the Committee and to make recommendations in this regard.</p>
Item 8b	<p>Proposals for Amendments to the Priority List for the Standardization of Processed Fruits and Vegetables The Committee may propose the removal and/or inclusion of new products for future work taking into account the <i>Proposals to Undertake New Work or to Revise a Standard</i> (Codex Alimentarius Procedural Manual, Part 2 Critical Review) and the work already done by other international standardization organizations in this field. Consideration of new work would also be in connection with the discussion and decision(s) taken under Agenda Item 8a.</p>

Item 9	Other Business Agenda Item 9a contains some outstanding matters relating to certain standards for processed fruits and vegetables for information and/or decision by the Committee. This includes, but may not be limited to, addition of methods of analysis in revised Codex standards for processed fruits and vegetables, pending provisions for packing media in the Standard for Pickled Fruits and Vegetables, revocation of certain Codex standards for processed fruits and vegetables in view of adoption of general standards, etc.
